



Discovering San Pedro 4 Days / 3 Nights

Day 01 Calama – San Pedro de Atacama

Met in the airport at Calama and then taken in a transfer to San Pedro (see daily timetables for transfer services). The journey is about 105km and will rise to an altitude of around 3100m. After an hour and 45 minutes, it will cross both the Domeyko and La Sal mountain ranges, as well as the Llano de Paciencia. Finally it will reach an oasis and then take all guests to their hotels.

Day 02 San Pedro de Atacama – Valle de la Luna

AM: Free morning.

PM: An excursion to Valle de la Luna. This section of the La Sal mountain range is known for its peculiar landscapes, colours, dunes, rocks, gorges and caverns etc. Many think that a satellite photo of the earth would look very similar to this large expanse of land. There will be time here for a short walk and photographs before returning to the hotel.

Day 03 San Pedro de Atacama – San Pedro de Atacama – Tatio Geiser + Machuca and Salt Flats + Toconao

AM: Leave early in the morning (around 4am) for the Geiser del Tatio, a stunning valley of steam and boiling volcanic water. The valley is situated 4380m above sea level. There will be the opportunity for short walks, giving time to admire the beauty of the landscape, watch the sunrise and observe the active geisers. Breakfast will be provided.

PM: Leave to head towards Toconao, a small town that's known for its old Church, Bell Tower and volcanic rocks that were used to make the houses. The tour will continue in the direction of the Salt Flats until it reaches Lake Chaxa. Here there will be the opportunity to see pink flamingos in their natural habitat. Watching the sunset is the perfect way to end this tour before returning back to the hotel.





Day 04 San Pedro de Atacama – Tour Arqueológico

AM: Excursion to some archeological sites nearby. El Pucará de Quito is a fortress built on the side of a hill overlooking the San Pedro oasis. It is where the bloody battle took place between the Lican Antai, Incas and Spanish army. Later on the tour will visit the area of Tulo, an old village filled with interesting architecture. The houses built in groups here reveal a large part of what the lives and culture of the builders must have been like. These houses, hidden underneath a layer of sand for thousands of years, have only recently been discovered. There will be free time for lunch (not included in the price).

PM: Leave for the airport in Calama to return to Santiago. (The flight will be after 6pm).
